



EMPLOYMENT EXPLORATION SERVICES

Employment Exploration Services is a 10-week program that includes a wide variety of activities which help participants explore different work options and opportunities in their community. The program combines classroom learning and job exploration activities to provide engaging work experiences and promote motivation, consideration of opportunities, and informed decision-making. This program helps participants transition to employment by gaining a better understanding of competitive employment, helping them decide if they want to work in the community and what kind of work they may want to perform. The program has a staff ratio of 1:4.
